

INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Acton, Maine is accepting sealed bids, with a minimum reserve of \$2,000, for a Surplus Vehicle, known as Forester 1.

- 1986 GMC Sierra 3500 4x4 with a utility style body
- 49092 miles with a GM 454 motor
- Pump: Hale Forestry Pump Model# 30FB-B42 (135GPM) with a Briggs and Stratton 18 HP motor
- Tank: 200 Gallon water tank. There is also a pre-piped 200' booster reel.
