

TOWN OF ACTON

EXCISE TAX EXEMPTION POLICY

This policy describes the criteria for obtaining an exemption from the motor vehicle excise tax for residents of the town of Acton.

ELIGIBILITY

The exemption is available to qualified veterans who have met one or more of the qualifications listed below:

- > Veteran is a recipient of the Purple Heart license plate with the Class Code of PH on a State of Maine, Town of Acton registration certificate;
- > Veteran's combined service connected evaluation is 100%, as indicated on their Veteran's "Summary of Benefits" statement from the Department of Veteran Affairs. Said veteran must also be the recipient of the Disabled Veteran license plate with a Class Code of DV on the State of Maine, Town of Acton registration certificate.
- > Veteran who is being paid at the 100% rate because he/she is unemployable and is totally and permanently disabled, as indicated on the Veteran's "Summary of Benefits" statement from the Department of Veteran Affairs. Said veteran must also be the recipient of the Disabled Veteran license plate with a Class Code of DV on the State of Maine, Town of Acton registration certificate.

OTHER CONDITIONS

Eligible veterans are entitled to a maximum of two exemptions for an automobile or truck which they own for their personal and non-commercial use.


For a vehicle(s) registered in the name of a veteran, the exemption continues until both spouses have died, or until the non-veteran spouse remarries.

Eligible veterans applying for new license plates should review the Secretary of State's required documentation contained in Title 29-A, Section 523.
