Treasurer's Disbursement Warrants for Wages and Benefits Policy

Purpose: This policy allows that in the event there is only one Selectman present and available to sign the payroll warrant, one Selectman, acting on behalf of the board, may review, approve and sign the municipal treasurer's disbursement warrants for wages and benefits only.

This policy is additional to, and not in lieu of majority power. Nothing in this policy is intended to replace the authority of the full board of Selectmen, acting by majority vote, to act on any treasurer's warrant, including warrants for wages and benefits.


Effective date: This policy becomes effective on the date indicated below.
