A "Yes" vote is to enact the initiated bill in its entirety. A "No" vote opposes the initiated bill in its entirety.

Ouestion 2: Bond Issue –

Bond Issue Do you favor a \$100,000,000 bond issue to build or improve roads, bridges, railroads, airports, transit facilities and ports and make other transportation investments, to be used to leverage an estimated \$253,000,000 in federal and other funds? Total estimated life time cost is \$127,500,000 representing \$100,000,000 in principal and \$27,500,000 in interest (assuming interest at 5% over 10 years). A "Yes" vote approves the issuance of up to \$100,000,000 in general obligation bonds to finance transportation-related activities. A "No" vote opposes the bond issue in its entirety.

A "Yes" vote would amend the Maine Constitution to add a right to food. A "No" vote opposes adoption of the constitutional amendment.
