

**TOWN OF ACTON  
SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
April 11, 2006**

**1. PUBLIC FORUM:** Davey Winchell asked when the road postings will be lifted. Selectmen said they have already started taking down the posters. Davey said his father was sent a registered letter stating he had violated the posting. He feels his father was singled out unfairly. Jim noted that selectmen had notified 6 violators. Winchell said his father was contacted by the State Police and they said the law requires that wood being hauled on posted roads needed to be split up into firewood size. He feels that this violation was blown out of proportion.

Andy Brazier asked what the current status of 13<sup>th</sup> street is. Tony said Kelly was in the office today and will be trying to obtain more easement deeds. Andy read from Planning Board minutes of the last Lavalley subdivision, stating 13<sup>th</sup> Street is a private road and not maintained by the Town.

David Cote says he does not want to see any action taken that will undermine the Ordinance. He asked what the next step will be - will the selectmen call a meeting with the Road Committee? Nancy said no action will be taken until 13<sup>th</sup> Street solidifies their actions.
