They got ahead of schedule and built the deck before he had obtained the permit. In cases like this, the fine is 4 x the permit cost, or, in this case, \$716. Because the owner had not been aware that the deck was built until after the fact, Ken recommends the fine be reduced to \$500. On a motion by Ted, selectmen approved Ken's recommendation.

Ken also noted that the Acton Fair Grounds Association have requested a permit for a holding tank for the camping area that needs to be signed off by the Selectmen. On a motion by Ted, it was voted to sign.
